Statement of Policy

Victory Credit Union is an ethical and caring financial institution providing many services to our communities. As such, Victory Credit Union is directed to facilitate the provision of student bursaries to be granted annually to area students who qualify.

Composition

The managing of these bursaries will be completed by the Cooperative Social Responsibility Committee. The Cooperative Social Responsibility Committee is responsible to, and reports to, the Board of Directors.

Availability of Applications

Application forms will be made available to the various local high schools, as well as in PDF form on the Victory Credit Union website at www.victorycreditunion.ca.

Selection and Presentation of Bursaries

Criteria for the awards will be based on and weighted equally between; academic achievement, co-operative community service, financial need and success in spite of extraordinary circumstances. Presentation will be made by a member of the Committee, a Director or a Branch Manager of Victory Credit Union. The Victory Credit Union representative will ensure a photographer is in attendance to take pictures of the presentation. The picture and a suitable caption may be published in the local newspaper, and on Victory Credit Union's website and social media.

Payment of Bursary

Disbursement will be made by cheque to the recipient at the time of presentation. If the recipient is not currently a member with Victory Credit Union, they must provide their SIN, to ensure tax forms can be completed and sent in a timely manner.

Amount of Bursary

Up to three (3) Victory Credit Union Bursaries will be awarded up to the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) to the appropriate recipients.

**Personal information shall not be used or disclosed for purposes other than those for which it was collected, except with the consent of the customer/owner or as required by law.
